- etc.


















Data Silos


1st Problem: Data Silos

- Most data lies outside DBMS
- Current operating systems use file-based storage,
 e.g., > 700,000 files on the authors laptop
- each application re-invents DBMS logic



2nd Problem: Lack of Query Processing Capabilities


- How to do queries that go beyond simple keyword search?
- How to search for stuff exploiting structure/schema information?
- How to join data from different files?


Consequence: a Desktop is an Information Jungle
